The minutes of April 19, 2020 were approved with the following corrections:

Meeting was conducted via Zoom video conferencing

Ric Dod wondered if the meeting files a 1099 tax form for our childcare workers.

Our new cleaning crew has not proved satisfactory and continuing to employ them would require us providing *worker's compensation insurance* and other complications.

The Treasurer's Report was given by Wendy Robinson and accepted with gratitude. Meeting approved donating \$3,000.00 to Linn-Benton Food Share. Jay Thatcher invited Friends to use some of their stimulus checks to donate funds to the L-B Food Share

Wendy noted that Friends can donate electronically into the Meeting's bank account and gave Friends at the meeting the routing and account numbers for an ACH transfer to the meeting (contact her for details).

Spiritual Care Committee reported that nineteen Friends have signed up to participate in Triangle phone trees (Friend 1 calls Friend 2 who calls

Friend 3 who calls Friend 1). They will be providing details to the participants soon.

The Meeting has a new Zoom account with a recurring link to use for online worship and meetings. Information about Meeting times and contact information will be sent to the Gazette-Times, Western Friend, the Meeting website and Facebook page. The link itself will not be published.

Nominating Committee report was approved with thanks. Terms begin July 1.

House and Hospitality provided an estimate from Maid to Perfection cleaning service. Abigail Stoughton reported that this company fits the requirements outlined by the meeting—living wages for employees, worker's compensation insurance, environmentally safe cleaning products, and hospital grade disinfectants. Meeting approved our hiring them. We will schedule a deep cleaning just before we resume in person worship and activities and regular cleaning every two weeks after that. The Meeting thanked Abigail for her work on this.

The Wednesday Digest email of announcements and notices of activities of interest to Friends has become overly full and difficult to read. Nancy Ewald and Wendy Robinson will develop a questionnaire for Friends to gather information on its use and the preferences of Friends. This information will help guide us prior to having a threshing session on the issue.
